Post-treatment photographs revealed a well-balanced straight facial profile, improved smile esthetics and maxillary and mandibular lip positions. Intra-oral photographs showed maxillary arch expansion, space consolidation in the maxillary and mandibular dental arches, a Class I molar and canine occlusal relationship, correction of the anterior open bite and retroclination of incisors into an ideal overjet and overbite relation. Both maxillary and mandibular dental midlines are aligned with the facial midline. Gingival margins and heights of contour improved around the anterior teeth. The labial frenum attachment remodeled into its normal position without surgical intervention. Lingual fixed retainers are shown extending from first premolar to first premolar in both arches.
