Post-treatment photographs show a significant improvement in the smile esthetics, correction of the smile line, and symmetric vertical incisor display. Intra-oral photographs show maxillary and mandibular arch development, aligned dentition in the maxillary and mandibular arches, normalized incisal inclination into an ideal overjet and overbite, and Cass I molar and canine occlusal relation. Both maxillary and mandibular dental midlines are aligned with the facial midline. Gingival margins and heights of contour improved around the anterior teeth. The morphology of the displaced dento-alveolar bone that affected the maxillary left central incisor, lateral incisor, and canine, was significantly improved. Lingual fixed retainers are shown extending from canine to canine on both arches.
